



Advisory Group Policy

InterFaith Alliance of the Southwest

Purpose: The Advisory Group of IFASW will serve as a consulting body to provide guidance, expertise, and strategic advice to support the IFASW's mission of fostering interfaith dialogue, collaboration, and community service.

Role and Responsibilities

- Provide non-binding strategic recommendations to the IFASW's leadership and Council.
- Serve as ambassadors of the Alliance to promote its mission and values.
- Offer expertise and insights on issues related to interfaith relations, diversity, and community-building.
- Help identify, build, and strengthen partnerships, resources, and potential leaders for service on the Council and other teams as needed.
- Participate in Council meetings as possible, requested Advisory Group meetings, and special initiatives as called upon by the Council.

Contributors

- The Advisory Group will consist of individuals with experience, knowledge, or influence in faith-based, nonprofit, educational, or community sectors.
- Contributors will be appointed by the IFASW Council based on recommendations given to the Council.
- Term of service is indefinite and will be negotiated with the IFASW Council.
- Advisory Group contributors will serve in a voluntary capacity with no fiduciary or governance authority over the Alliance.

Ethical Standards and Expectations

- Advisory Group contributors will uphold the values of mutual respect, inclusivity, and integrity in all matters related to IFASW.
- Contributors must disclose any potential conflicts of interest and refrain from activities that could compromise the objectivity or mission of IFASW.
- IFASW reserves the right to remove any Advisory Group member whose actions or statements are inconsistent with its mission or ethical standards.
